With over 1,300 arrowmen attending Conclave, it is going to be a busy weekend. Here are some guidelines for you as you enter Camp Bowers on Friday night in order to ensure the success and safety of everyone.

Remember, Conclave is a "shared space" event, so please be considerate of others at all times. A Scout is clean.

1. Safety is our most important concern!
2. Please drive no faster than 4 MPH on camp property.
3. Watch out for scouts crossing the road.
4. Take note of the one way roads. If you miss your site, please circle around and try again.
5. This is not a DRIVING permit. Once your car is parked, please do not move it until departure on Sunday.
6. Following arrival and unloading, please remove vehicles from your campsite and park in assigned areas to allow others access to campsites. Please follow signs for parking.
7. During shows on Friday night and Saturday night, and on Sunday morning during closing ceremonies and church service: The main road next to Eagle Field will be closed to traffic (see map).
